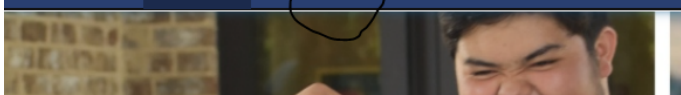

- *is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived, and
- *is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- *Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
